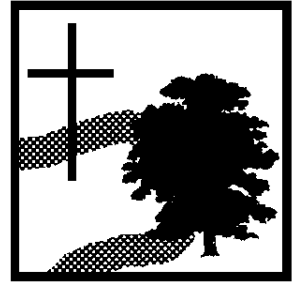

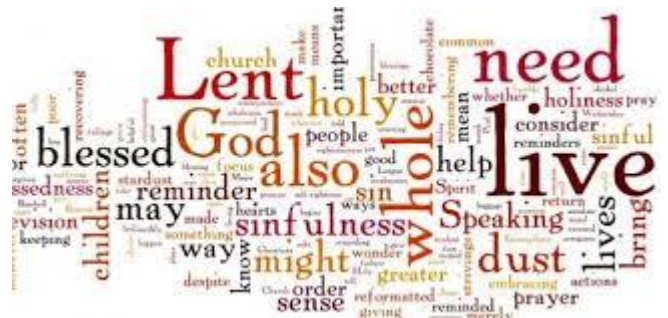

Change looms large in 2025. Justin Welby stood down as Archbishop of Canterbury on his 69th birthday, January 6th. The Bishop of St Albans, Alan Smith, will retire on 31st May, aged 68. I will be 70 in June so I too must retire. My last Sunday will be a joint benefice service in Watton at Stone 10am on June 1st.

Change is often unsettling and upsetting. Letting go of a role, home and community we love is hard. But we can choose to see change positively, as an adventure with new possibilities and fresh opportunities, not negatively as threat and loss. We can't change *what* we face - *How* we face it is down to us. We don't know who will replace us, but God hasn't retired! God is faithful and never leaves us.

Jesus encourages us to give thanks in all circumstances for everything we have. St Paul's words to the Church at Philippi apply to us all: *'Rejoice in the Lord always... Stand firm in the Lord... the Lord is near. Do not worry about anything... And the peace of God which surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.'*

Letting go and trusting God are part of Lent which begins on Ash Wednesday 5th March. Lent challenges us where our security lies - in our work? health? relationships? wealth?... all these will end one day! Lent invites us to let go of our sense of entitlement and admit our dependence on God - everything we have is GM, God Made! True security/salvation lies in God whose love endures forever.



What are we making of our time on earth? How do we want others to remember us? Like New Year, Lent is a time for new resolutions... time to take the hand God holds out to us, in gratitude and trust and find in Him the courage, strength and direction we need each day: *'I said to the man who stood at the gate of the year: 'Give me a light that I may tread safely into the unknown. And he replied: 'Go out into the darkness and put your hand in the hand of God. That will be to you better than a light and safer than a known way.'*

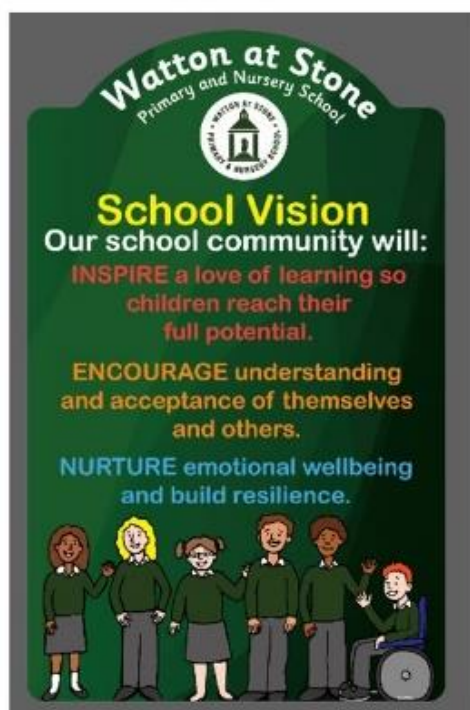
Watton Village Fete 2025

Waterford Nature Notes



Over the years, I have come across several methods by which the age of trees can be calculated without cutting them down and counting the rings. A common method for Oaks, many years ago was to measure the girth at a height of 5 feet and reckon one year for every half inch for a tree growing within a wood but one year for every inch for a tree growing in the open. The difficulty with this method is that, without accurate mapping, the best of which is Ordnance Survey, the first of which was drawn in 1801, it is difficult to tell whether a particular tree was always in the open or in a wood. Several other methods rely on calculations of diameter as determined by using circular geometry and even guesses. A few weeks ago, I came across a website that has a table of actual measurements of known trees with their ages and the reigning monarch at the time of their seeding. At the top of Timber Orchard, growing on the boundary of Goldings, there is a large Oak. I measured the girth at a height of 1.5m and found it to be just over 16 feet. The table describes an oak with a girth of 16'6", planted in 1715 in the reign of George 1 during the first Jacobite Rebellion. Oak trees were often used to mark boundaries so it is likely that this tree was planted as such a marker. Goldings estate was established around 1700, this all seems to fit together.

As he does each year, my Somerset correspondent reported on the frogs in his pond. The first spawn appeared 1st February. There was also a report from Somerset of a, presumably male, frog locked onto one of his Goldfish. I have come across this before and might even have reported upon it; the instinct to mate is so strong that the frogs can become indiscriminate - hormones, eh? At the time of 'going to press' I have yet to hear or see frogs in our pond, let alone any spawn.

Two of the lovely sounds of the approach of Spring are Thrushes and Blackbirds singing early in the morning of 9th February, I heard my first Song Thrush of the year, I have yet to hear a Blackbird. Contrary to what many people think, the Blackbird is actually the more melodious and varied of the two. Both species are usually silent from late Summer until early Spring when they again begin to mate and establish territories.

There seems to me to be a high number of Robins establishing their territory and trying to attract mates, within a radius of no more than 60-70 metres of our garden, I have seen five or six active in posturing and/or singing to establish territory, one was carrying nesting material into shrubbery at the back of our garden during the first week of February.



If you are interested in the natural world around you and haven't tried this before, have a go at keeping a diary. I have twice kept a diary for one year in which I recorded sightings, by date, species, location and other remarks. In following years, I was able to compare such matters as the earliest a particular species was seen or heard, numbers recorded, etc., some changes were obvious and considerable, others were more subtle in others there wasn't any change.



During a visit to North Yorkshire, we passed a sign notifying that we were entering an "Animal Control Zone". The zone was designated on 7th February following the identification of an outbreak of a 'highly pathogenic' strain of Avian Flu in poultry, i.e. it will result in disease when present. The relevant law is quite stringent - think back to the 2001 outbreak of Foot and Mouth Disease. This will have just as much effect upon poultry farmers as did the 2001 outbreak although this is not nearly as widespread. There are several dozen control zones in force at present, mostly Avian Flu but also several caused by Bluetongue disease, a disease that affects cattle, sheep, goats, deer, and other ruminants (cud-chewing mammals). Spare a thought for the farmers that are affected, life is difficult enough for farmers.

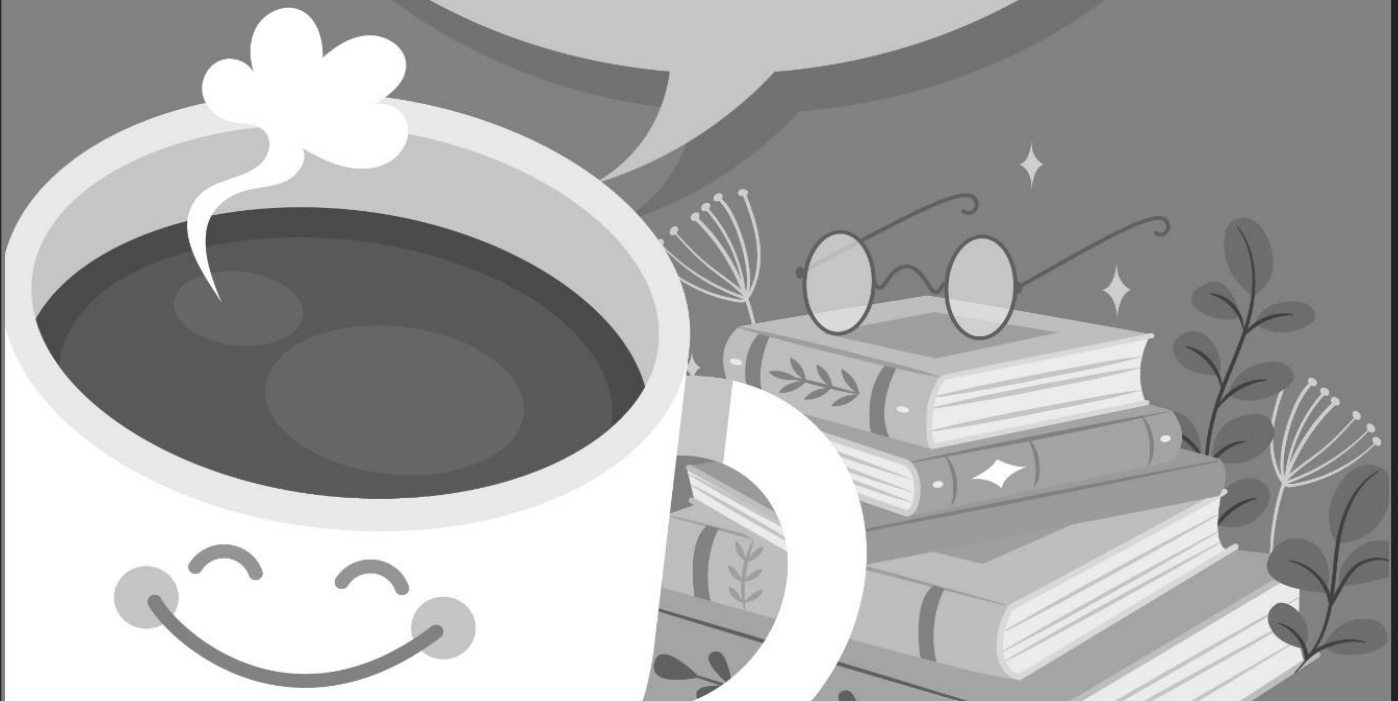



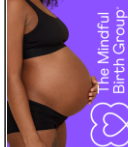
